Sound of the alarm

The sound of the alarm will be a shouted warning of: “Fire Evacuate”.
This warning should be repeated at least 3 times.

Raising the alarm

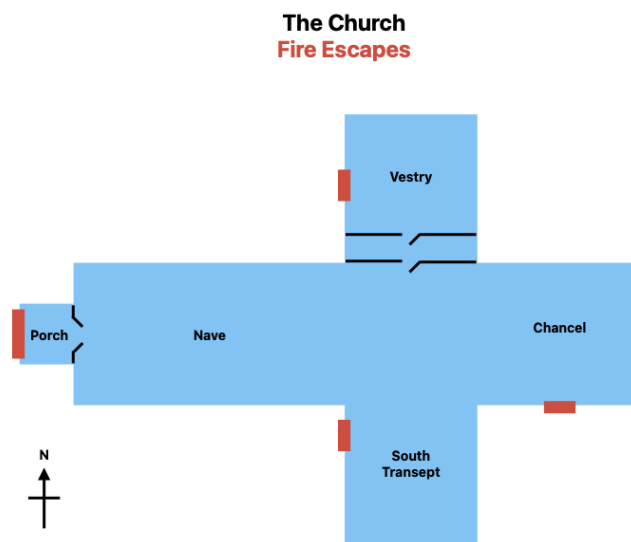
If the fire is discovered by a member of the congregation, they should immediately inform a Verger or Church Warden, who will raise the alarm during the service.

If the fire is discovered by a visitor during the week, when the church is not occupied, they should leave the building, dial 999 and request the Fire Service.

Action to be taken on hearing the alarm

1. A Verger and/or Church Warden will lead the Fire Evacuation.
2. Inform people of which fire escapes to use.
3. Commence the evacuation directing people to the fire assembly point. This should be undertaken in a calm and orderly manner. Pay particular attention to children and people with mobility issues.
4. Dial 999 and request attendance of the Fire Service.
5. Make a visual sweep of the building ensuring that no one is left inside. Pay particular attention to any person that might be in the Vestry or the Bell Tower. **Personal safety takes priority and at no point should a person put themselves in danger. Ensure there is a clear means of escape.**
6. Post someone by the building at a safe distance to ensure no one re-enters the building.
7. Communicate with the evacuated congregation to ensure everyone is accounted for.
8. Liase with the fire service upon their arrival. If anyone is unaccounted for, inform the fire service immediately.
9. Keep people calm and informed. No one should leave until told to do so by the Fire Service. No one should re-enter the building until told it is safe to do so by the Fire Service.

Fire assembly point

The fire assembly point is the car park in front of the Rectory.

Fighting fires – Extinguisher use

Fire extinguishers will only be used where:

- A person has received training and feels confident in their use.
- Where it is deemed safe to do so. **Ensure there is a clear means of escape.**

Personal safety always takes priority and if in any doubt people should not attempt to extinguish a fire.

Equipment needed to implement the Fire Evacuation Plan

Vergers and Church Wardens should have mobile phones.

Variations to plan

If a Verger or Church Warden is not present, they should arrange for someone to act in the role of Fire Evacuation leader.

Visitors to the Church should leave the building, dial 999 and ask for the Fire Service.
